



Dear Pastor Gordon & CHBC Brethren,

Greetings from Vietnam!

I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. [Philippians 3:14]

It is the calling of God in Christ Jesus and His enablement through the Holy Spirit that sustains and strengthens to PRESS ON and to PERSEVERE in the ministry. It is not our PERSEVERANCE that keeps us in the ministry, but His keeping that makes us persevere in the ministry. Because, faithful is He that calleth you who also will do it. It humbles us and makes us ever grateful to see what the Lord is doing in our lives and in the ministry He called us in Vietnam in the midst of this pandemic. We have taken our theme for this from this text which is, FOLLOW THROUGH.

OCTOBER – In preparation for our Faith Promise Conferences and Church Anniversaries both in Saigon and Hanoi I started a series of messages on Grace for Grace taken from John 1:16. We are thankful to the Lord how His word sustains His people especially in times when we cannot assemble on site. The pandemic kept us from going up to Hanoi for several weeks, so we focussed on attending to the needs of our people in Saigon and also on our ABCs of Christian Maturity discipleship program. We are thankful to the Lord for the faithfulness of our staff and co-laborers in the Hanoi ministry.

NOVEMBER – We had our combined 10th GBIMC Faith Promise Conference in Saigon and 2nd Faith Promise Conference for Hanoi on November 6 & 7. The Faith Promise Mission Conference is always the main highlight of the year for our ministries in Vietnam. It is the time to challenge our people to increase their faith in their giving in order to support more missionaries both local and foreign. It was a great blessing to have Pastor John Wyn and Missionary Joel Basilan to challenge our people in Vietnam on the theme BEYOND from 2 Corinthians 10:16. It is amazing how the Lord is blessing our people and enabling them to exercise their faith to give to mission especially our members in Hanoi.

Last November 18, I had the unique and rare opportunity to destroy two buddhist altars and dedicate the office building of Brother Manh, our member in Hanoi. The 2 altars with the gods of money and the gods of land were placed by a former business partner. When Brother Manh and Ms. Thuy got convicted about, they severed partnership with the man and requested me to destroy the altar and dedicate the building. The decision was really very very costly financially and troublesome to them, but the Lord honored them and now He is building and blessing their mining company.

DECEMBER – On December 5 we celebrated Amazing Grace Baptist Mission 6th anniversary in Hanoi. It is truly amazing how the grace of God has sustained us in Hanoi this past six years. It is also amazing how the mission work is slowly growing in number and in the spiritual maturity of the people. That day we were also privileged to baptize three precious souls and added them to the AGBM membership. Please, pray as we prepare to organize Hanoi between the first and second quarter of 2022.

On November 26 we celebrated Grace Baptist International Mission Church 12th anniversary in Saigon. We thank the Lord for blessing GBIMC and using it to reach Vietnam with the gospel and to support missions in different fields since the time we started in 2008. Please, pray for GBIMC as many of our members are losing their jobs and opting to be repatriated back to the Philippines because of the pandemic. We believe that God has still a purpose for GBIMC and that we have to be diligent in soul-winning and discipling to remain significant in the mission movement in Vietnam.

Thank you so much brethren for your friendship and fellowship in the gospel and for the sacrificial giving in upholding us not just through your prayers, but also through your financial support. May the Lord also keep you all healthy and strong and continue to use you and bless you in the ministry!
